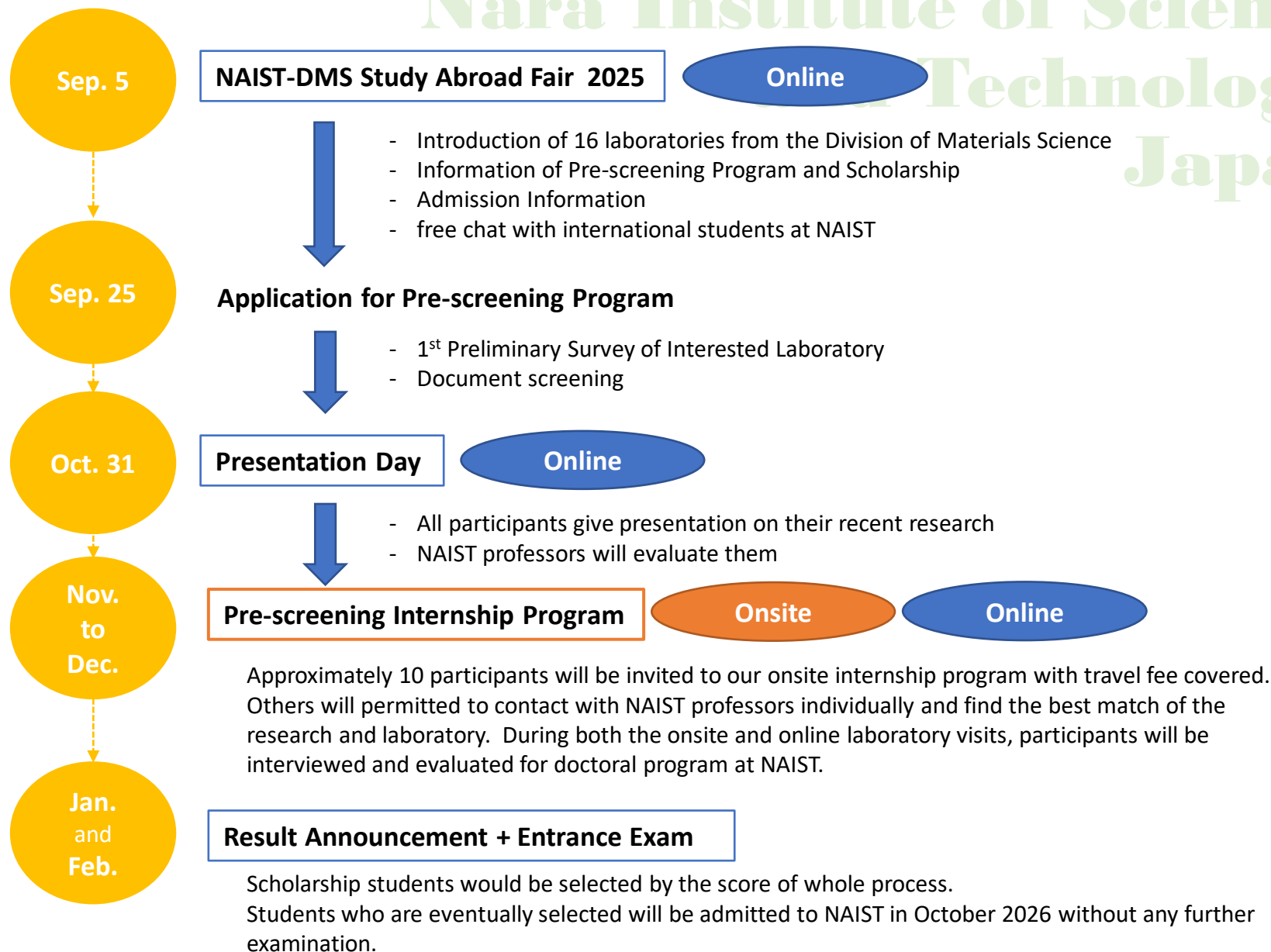

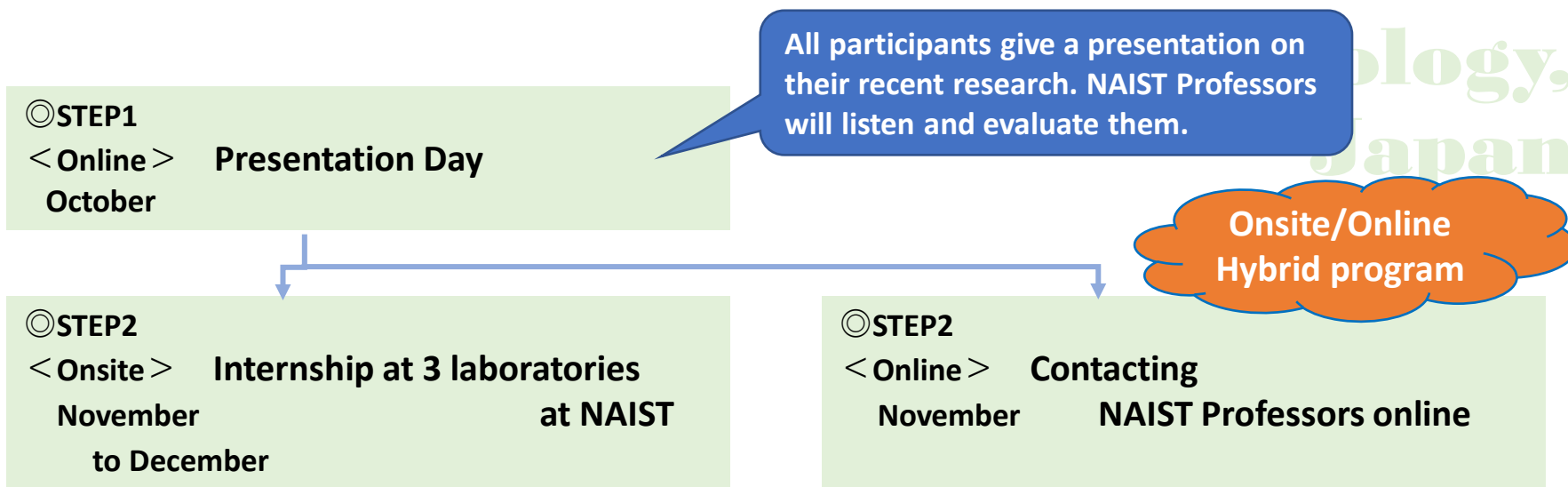

To find the right laboratory which your research interest matches

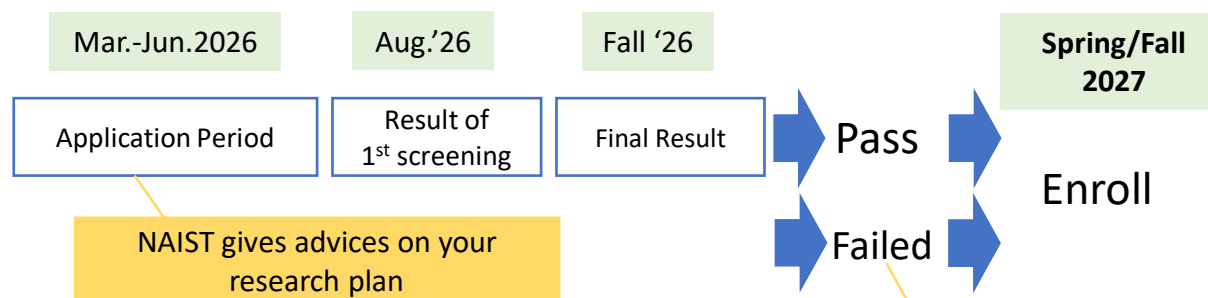

Others will be permitted to contact with NAIST professors individually and find the best match of the research and laboratory. During both the onsite and online laboratory visits, participants will be interviewed and evaluated for doctoral program at NAIST.

MEXT Scholarship(university recommendation) and other scholarship candidates will be selected from participants in this program.

All participants are suggested to apply for the **MEXT Japanese Embassy Recommendation** from their home country. NAIST faculty will assist you in writing your **“Research Plan”** which is the most important part of your application.
