

Contact Period with the laboratories

Before applying, applicants should contact the laboratories in which they are interested to find the two whose research matches theirs.

CV (use NAIST format)

Research Proposal (two A4 pages), covering:

- The contents of your undergraduate study
- The research field/project that you wish to work on at NAIST

Transcripts of Bachelor Course School Records

Document to Verify English Proficiency

5-minute Presentation Video

◎STEP1 : First Screening Document Screening

All applicants submit a **five-minute** presentation video along with their application documents. NAIST Professors will review and evaluate these submissions.

◎STEP2 : Second Screening < Onsite > Internship at 2 laboratories at NAIST

(1 week from July 27 to August 1)


Approximately 10 participants will be invited to our onsite internship program with travel fee covered. During laboratory visits, participants will be interviewed and evaluated for master's program at NAIST.

The scholarship candidates will be selected from participants in this program.

All participants are suggested to apply for the **MEXT Japanese Embassy Recommendation** from their home country. NAIST faculty will assist you in writing your **“Research Plan”** which is the most important part of your application.

Even if the applicant failed the MEXT embassy recommendation, NAIST will consider to assign MEXT university recommendation to the participants of pre-screening program with higher grades.*

*The proof of your application for the MEXT Embassy Recommendation, such as a receipt email, result announce letter or email from embassy, will be required.
