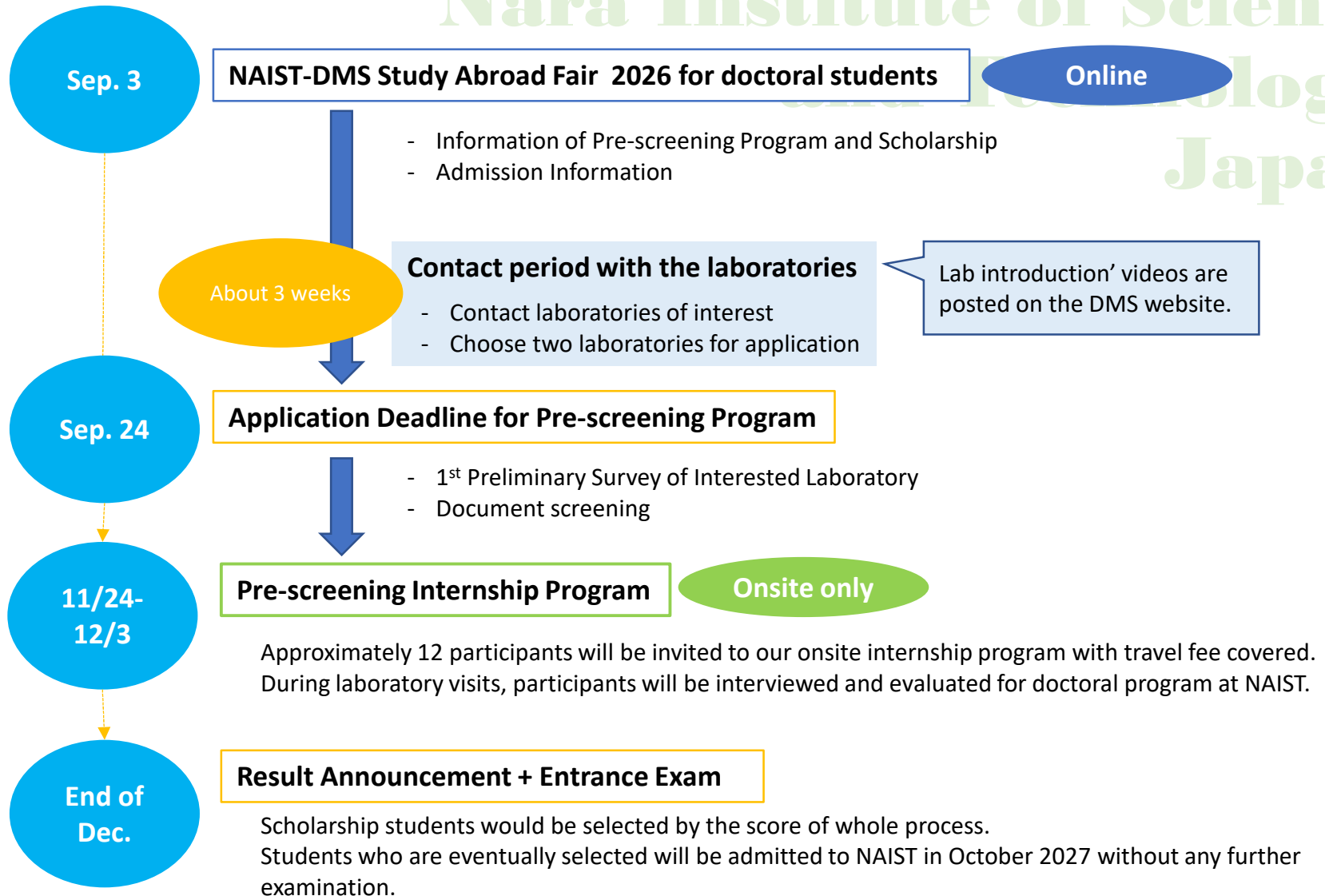

Contact Period with the laboratories

Before applying, applicants should contact the laboratories in which they are interested to find the two whose research matches theirs.

◎STEP1 : First Screening Document Screening

All applicants submit a **five-minute** presentation video along with their application documents. NAIST Professors will review and evaluate these submissions.

- CV (use NAIST format)
- Academic transcripts of Bachelor and Master program
- Research experience and background
 - Any format is acceptable / Five A4-size pages max
- Research plan
 - Any format is acceptable / Two A4-size pages
 - Cover the following subjects:
 - The contents of master's thesis
 - The research field/project you want to work on at NAIST after the enrollment
- Certification to Verify English Proficiency
- 5-minute Presentation Video**

◎STEP2 : Second Screening < Onsite > Internship at 2 laboratories at NAIST

(10 days from November 24 to December 3)

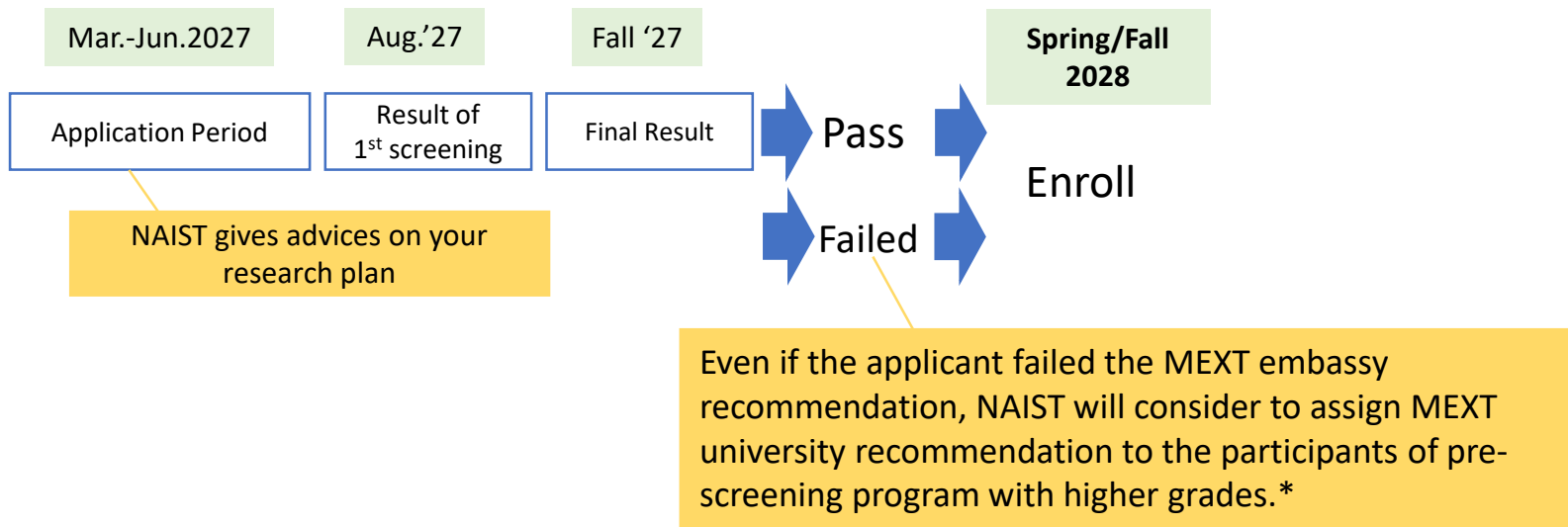
Approximately 12 participants will be invited to our onsite internship program with travel fee covered. During laboratory visits, participants will be interviewed and evaluated for master's program at NAIST.

The scholarship candidates will be selected from participants in this program.
